

REMIX INHAMBANE

REMIXINHAMBANE PRESS RELEASE

Remixinhambane is a network prototype that connects artists with producers and facilitates music production over geographic and musical frontiers. The project was initiated in 2011 by Maximilian Kamenar and Roland Pickl.



Remixinhambane was conceived when the Mozambiquan singer Paulo Vumo rushed into *Studio Bom Dia* in Mozambique, Africa and asked Maximilian Kamenar to produce his song. Due to lack of time, only the voice was recorded, with plans to finish the track at home in Austria. Back in Vienna, Maximilian handed the track over to musician and producer friends who completed several versions of the song. This revelatory experience led to the birth of the project which currently has 27 songs from 20 artists online and over 80 finished remixes.

As the concept matured, it was implemented into Inhambane City (the capitol of the Mozambiquan province Inhambane) with local musicians. Songs from these African singers were recorded as multi-track recordings at *Studio Bom Dia* in Mozambique and then made available online for download. With these audio tracks it was possible for everybody to make their own interpretations and re-mixes of the material; from new arrangements to the production of completely new songs.

Now *Remixinhambane* is being transformed into a platform that will make it possible for anyone to realize such projects anywhere in the world. The goal of *Remixinhambane* is to discover and support new talent and the collaboration of music production over cultural and geographical frontiers.

During the **Summer of Sound** at the *MuseumsQuartier* in Vienna, we are announcing an "Open Call" to participate in the project. Workshops about the project and contemporary music production have been organized and the results will then be presented at a CD presentation in September 2014.
